Other documents depicted the spread of Buddhism as a foreign invasion of the superior China. Han Yu's memorial (Document 4) and the Emperor's edict in Document 6 both blame Buddhism for tainting the people of China. Document 4 addresses growing feelings of nationalism in China; which resulted in a growing stand for Confucianism, since it was a belief system founded in China. Document 6, on the other hand, revealed not a strengthening of the state, but a weakening.
