Common Responsorial Psalms and Gospel Acclamations

Speak, Lord, for your servant is listening. You have the words of eternal life. 1 Samuel 3.9; John 6.68. Alleluia. Alleluia, alleluia. I am the light of the world, says the Lord. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness. but will have the light of life. cf John 8.12.

Gospel Acclamations - Ordinary Time

During Lent, the Gospel Acclamation takes on a special form, It is chosen from one of 8 refrains, followed by a verse. The refrains are all forms of praise to Jesus, and the verses are normally from the scriptures, and often from the Psalter.

In the fifth week we have John’s story of the woman taken in adultery (only found in John’s Gospel), and the Acclamation is a beautiful, incredibly appropriate verse from Joel ‘Even now, says the Lord, return to me with your whole heart, for I am gracious and merciful’ (there’s a UK possible alternative ‘Seek good and not evil’, but I would choose the Joel verse myself).

Lent Gospel Acclamations : an update - Music for Mass

In Lent (dealt with elsewhere) the alleluia was a verse called a tractus. Renè-Jean Hesbert, in his Antiphonale Missarum Sextuplex, still the authoritative collection of antiphons, suggests that the antiphon verses used with the Alleluia at the Gospel Acclamation were to be chosen freely. The problem arises because each country-group Missal can choose any of the optional Lent Gospel Acclamations to go with any set Gospel verse, which offers a dizzying number of possibilities. Most parishes don’t actually want to have a new Acclamation every week as well as the new Gospel verse.

In the Gospel Acclamation, the assembled faithful welcome ‘the Lord who is about to speak to them.’ The cantor may intone the Acclamation, which is repeated by the whole assembly. After the cantor or choir sings the verse, the entire assembly again sings the Acclamation.

The Responsorial Psalm settings provided jazz chords to accompany the cantor’s verses, and the Gospel Acclamation was a jaunty little 6/8 melody that bore the name “Celtic Alleluia,” though in what way it was “Celtic” I never discovered. The Propers of the Mass are liturgical texts that vary from day to day according to the calendar: the Introit, the Gradual, the Responsorial Psalm, the Alleluia Verse (and the Lenten Tract which substitutes for it), the Offertory Chant, and the Communion Antiphon.

Should the verse for the Gospel acclamation be read or sung between sung Alleluias? The Introduction to the Lectionary for Mass says this about the acclamation before the reading of the Gospel at Mass: The Alleluia, or, as the liturgical season requires, the verse before the gospel, is also a ‘rite or act standing by itself’.

The initial letter of each title make a Latin acrostic (when read backwards) 'Ero cras' — I will come tomorrow. The antiphons are also the basis of the Gospel Acclamations for the week prior to Christmas. It will noted that a different translation is used as well as a different order.

The alleluia or the verse before the gospel may be omitted if not sung. Music in Catholic Worship The Memorial Acclamation can be a simple repeated refrain punctuated by Alleluia or in Lent another expression of joy. If incense is used the Book of the Gospel is incensed three times in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
