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Landlord And Tenant Law

Landlord-tenant law governs the rental of commercial and residential property. It is composed primarily of state statutes and common law. A number of states have based their statutory law on either the Uniform Residential Landlord And Tenant Act (URLTA) or the Model Residential Landlord-Tenant Code.

Changes in New York State Rent Law

If a lease exists (written or oral) or if a landlord has previously accepted payment as rent, a New York renter has certain rights under New York landlord tenant law (NY Real Property Law §§ 220 - 238A). These include protections from illegal landlord retaliation, the right to habitable housing and more.

Landlord and Tenant Law. House Bills 4204 and 4213 went into effect on June 30, 2020, during the Oregon Legislature's First Special Session of 2020. HB 4204 directs lenders to defer both residential and commercial mortgage payments until September 30, 2020, due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Landlord Tenant Act - Nebraska

The VRLTA, Sections 55.1-1200 through 55.1-1262 of the Code of Virginia, was initially enacted into law in 1974. The VRLTA establishes the rights and obligations of landlords and tenants in Virginia. The VRLTA supersedes all local, county, and municipal landlord and tenant ordinances. It also prohibits certain lease clauses.

Virginia Residential Landlord and Tenant Act

The landlord must serve the tenant a written notice allowing three days, excluding weekends and legal holidays, for the payment of the rent or vacating of the premises. If the tenant does not pay the rent or vacate, the landlord may begin legal action to evict.

"Landlord" means the owner, lessor, or sublessor of the dwelling unit or the building of which such dwelling unit is a part. "Landlord" also includes a managing agent of the premises who fails to disclose the name of such owner, lessor, or sublessor. Such managing agent shall be subject to the provisions of § 16.1-88.03.
