Answer: A working definition of incarnational ministry is "the immersion of one's self into a local culture and 'becoming Jesus' to that culture." Incarnational ministry seeks to dispense with ministry "from a distance" and embrace ministry "up close and personal"—the love of God and the gospel of Christ are "incarnated" or embodied by the person ministering.

Christians who adhere to incarnational ministry models or theology immerse themselves in a culture to represent Jesus (sometimes said "to be Jesus") to the people there. Many say they "live the good news rather than preach the good news" and "become Jesus" in the culture they minister within.
